

## **Participant Code of Conduct – CityHack18**

By participating in CityHack18, you are agreeing to comply by the Participant Code of Conduct outlined below. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact AECOM on 07717 652859.

### **Intellectual Property**

All submissions to CityHack18 will become Public Disclosure. AECOM will assert no rights of any kind in your team's work. Each prototype, mock-up or code presented is the property of your team. Your team is fully responsible for protecting any ideas, intellectual property or other rights which may exist in your work and will be publicly disclosed. By registering, consenting to the terms of the Hackathon, and entering a Submission, however, the Participant agrees that the organisers and event partners reserve an irrevocable, non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use, distribute to the public, and publicly display a Submission for a period of one year starting on the date of the announcement of contest winners (28 January 2018) as an example of work. We encourage participants to share their hacks with the greater community and promote innovation in this space. By submitting a CityHack18 Entry or accepting any prize, you represent and warrant that you will not submit content that is copyrighted, protected by trade secret or otherwise subject to third party intellectual property rights or other proprietary rights, including privacy and publicity rights, unless you are the owner of such rights or have permission from their rightful owner to post.

### **Social Media and Communications**

As a participant of CityHack18 and in sharing the event in any way, especially on social media, you will not publish falsehoods or misrepresentations that could damage CityHack18, Sponsors, or any third party. CityHack18 will not be obligated to pay any compensation to, or permit any participation by, any third party in connection with the use, reproduction, modification, publication, display or other exploitation of any of the content that you submit; and the content submitted by you does not contain any viruses, Trojan horses, worms or other disabling devices or harmful code. All content, communications and social media posts will avoid being unlawful or offensive in any way.

1. Viability
2. Customer Validation
3. Scalability
4. Prototype
5. Pitch

## **Eligibility**

CityHack18 organisers have the right to determine appropriate participants for CityHack18. A maximum number of participants is allowed and those who are selected for CityHack18 are at the sole discretion of organisers. Organisers may disqualify participants at any point for any reason including violation of this participant Code of Conduct.

## **Behaviour**

We encourage an inclusive environment and inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated at CityHack18. If a participant engages in any inappropriate behaviours including harassment of any kind, the hackathon organisers may take any action they deem appropriate. This includes warning the offender, expulsion from the hackathon, or reporting their behaviour to local law enforcement.

## **Photography**

Photography is encouraged, but other participants must be given a reasonable chance to opt out from being photographed. If they object to the taking of their photograph, please comply with their request. Please make sure photographs are appropriate.
